

CSAS K-5 Continued Learning Playbook 2020

Guiding Principles for Continued Learning:

Continue to hold our high expectations while recognizing wide variations in family circumstances.

Continue to make lessons highly engaging and encourage student involvement.

Put students first in all our expectations.

Assume the best intentions for everyone involved.

Common Expectations:

- Grade levels will create a weekly calendar of assignments to share with parents and students.
- Communication will take place across various platforms; Class Dojo, Google Classroom, Remind, email, phone.
- Grade levels will select one classroom learning platform and a maximum of two additional online platforms (ex., Reading Eggs, Freckle, iReady, etc.) for assignments.
- Teacher contact hours are weekdays, 9-11AM and 1-4PM. Any emails or messages received after that time will be returned the next workday.

Assignments and Expectations:

- Students will work to the best of their ability to complete assignments independently. When they have questions, they will contact their teacher using the approved methods.
- Teachers will provide timely feedback and opportunity for revision.
- The goal of current instruction and student engagement is to reach skill competency.
- Student assignments will be accepted in flexible arrangements - via photos, online submission, and other means agreed upon by teacher and parent.
- Students receiving special education services will be contacted weekly by an assigned provider.
- Grade level teams will determine positive incentives for student work completion.
- All students who complete weekly work will earn **Play Points**. **Play Points** will be redeemed at a **Play Day** including bouncy houses, games, prizes, treats, and more.

School Agreements:

- All students will be provided a working Chromebook with charger upon request - while HCS supplies last. Sites listed at www.hcde.org
- Technical help is provided by calling 423-493-0350
- Meals will be provided for all children according to the HCS plan found at www.hcde.org Under Family Resources - Food Resources
- The school building will be open to teachers and parents 10-2 daily (unless otherwise communicated by HCS). Call upon arrival 423-498-6845 or use buzzer at doors #2 and/or #8.
- Some families with limited or no internet access will be provided access points if not direct access through HCS and EPB. WiFi hotspots are available around the county - see www.hcde.org - Family Resources - Public WiFi Locations
- Communication is expected from students weekly. If not, the teacher will reach out, then counselor, then principal, then HCS staff to ensure contact is made.
- Spring Break will be observed April 3-12. No school for teachers or students.
